THE RULES SO FAR AS SCORECARDS ARE CONCERNED

We need to clarify the situation on Scorecards from this point forth. It is your responsibility to ensure that your card is completed correctly.

- From July onwards you must indicate the score of the player you are marking, the net score and the Stableford points for the hole. At the end of the round your card MUST be

completed with all this data and the total points indicated in the box designated for this function

- The card MUST be handed in to the Scorer and placed in the box provided before this is removed for evaluation of the cards.
- All cards must be signed by both Marker and Player.
- Any Card not placed in the box on time MUST be handed directly to the Administration office next to the Caddy Master / Buggy garage.
- Any card not handed in under these conditions will NOT be considered as valid and will not count towards the final classification nor Order of Merit total.
