

The Sant Jordi Golf Society Rules and Regulations



The Spectrum IFA Group Order of Merit



The Spectrum IFA Order of Merit will run from May and ends at the Sant Jordi Major in April the following year and runs as follows:

The Top 8 results from the qualifying tournaments in this period will count towards the Final Classification in the O.O.M

Players will score only in the category in which they start the season. If they play an event in a different category the points go to the category in which they started.

All Participants can score in all the events with the exception of the first tournament played in Sant Jordi events.

* In Major Events all the Place points are doubled

New members to the Society will not be able to win in their first event until they have an official federation handicap. The First place prize, trophy and Order of Merit points in this instance would go to the first qualifying players and so on respectively.

Major Tournaments

There are three Major Tournaments during the year. These are the Masters, the Sant Jordi and the Saint Andrews Tournaments. The Saint Jordi Event is the Principal Major and is played in April as a Stroke Play event over 18 holes at Osona Montanya Golf Club. The Saint Andrews Tournament is also Strokeplay and is Played in November. The Masters is a single category stableford event. All Majors are played in Category A as Strokeplay with and B as stableford.

Qualification for the Majors

1. Those players that have a Handicap of 18.4 and below on the day of the Event will participate in Category A.
2. Those players who have won previous Major Tournaments and Hall of Fame members may choose to play in Category A with a handicap limit of 18

In case of a tie in a classification

Equal position points are awarded for place positions in both categories.

In the event of a tie the lower handicap player will be awarded the winners position. If a tie still exists the player scoring most Gross Eagles, then birdies, then pars will decide the position. If a tie still exists the lowest score on the front 9 [holes 1 to 9] will decide the winner.

In the event of a tie at the end of the Saint Jordi Event in May 2011, the player with most victories will be declared the winner of the Order of Merit.

In the event of a tie in victories the player with most second places will be declared the winner of the Order of Merit.

In the event of a tie in second places the player with most third places will be declared the winner of the Order of Merit.

In the event of a tie in third places the player with most fourth places will be declared the winner of the Order of Merit.

In the event of a tie in third places the player with most fourth places will be declared the winner of the Order of merit.

And so on with Successive placings down to twentieth place.

NO points will be awarded for Cancelled or Partially finished Tournaments

No points will be awarded to a player disqualified under the Rules of Golf
